Directions to Room 3.38:

Route 1:

1. Pass through the main gate and continue straight until you reach the back wall of the Residenz.

2. Once you're at the back wall, you'll notice a substantial wooden door on the right-hand side.

3. Enter through this door and either take the stairs or use the elevator to reach the third floor.

4. For your orientation, Room 3.38 is situated above the "Toskana-Saal".

5. On the third floor, after ascending the stairs or exiting the elevator, make your way to the opposite end of the hall.

6. Proceed through the glass door, and you'll find Room 3.38 as the third room on your right.7. On the third floor, you will likely encounter people from the workshop already and finding the room will be easy.

Route 2:

1. Take the main entrance of the Institute of Philosophy. In the first room on the right side, the secretary of the Institute of Philosophy can help you find your way if you get lost.
